General Project Scope

Homrich performed demolition of a 175,000 square foot, (8) story steel framed hospital and various smaller buildings scattered throughout the project site. The project included the removal and disposal of all hazardous materials, (85,000 square foot of ceiling plaster, 3,500 square foot of Asbestos Pipe Fittings, & 60,000 square foot of floor tile and mastic. Homrich also removed the existing windows and caulking which contained asbestos. During the demolition process approximately 21,000 tons of concrete was crushed on site and utilized for backfill. 1,800 tons of scrap and recyclables were moved from the job site.
