Crisler Arena has been the location for Michigan athletic events for more than 40 years. The men's basketball team has called Crisler its home since the arena opened in 1967, and the women's hoops team has used the arena since its inaugural season as a varsity sport in 1973-74. In addition to hosting the Wolverines on the hardcourt, Crisler Arena has hosted several wrestling and gymnastics events over the years as well, becoming a second home on campus for those teams.

General Project Scope

Project consisted of the interior renovation of the basketball arena including demolition and removal of 10 large air handlers, sound absorbers, and associated vibration pads in a mechanical space 120' above the court floor. A Brokk and bobcat were utilized to demolish and load the debris into 10 yard roll off containers that were then lifted through an opening in the roof and transported to the ground via crane.

Numerous architectural removals included all 1034 lower and upper bowl concrete steps, utilizing dustless demolition hammers; removal of all catwalk decking and other miscellaneous architectural finishes.
